

The submission and review of papers for ICT 2016 will be managed through an online conference paper management system called “EasyChair”.

Login or create an account at EasyChair

In order to submit a paper you need to have an account with EasyChair. If you have used EasyChair in the past for another conference, go to <https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=ict2016> and use the same login details (use the “Forgot your password” utility, if needed)

If you don’t have an account go to <https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=ict2016> and click “create an account” as shown below.

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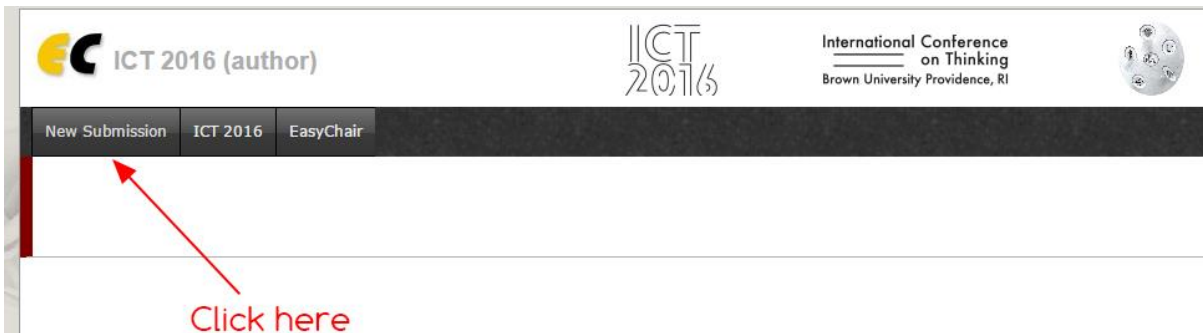

The submission process is very straightforward:

- **Email address** will only be used for communication with the authors. It will not appear in public Web pages of this conference. The email address can be omitted for authors who are not corresponding. These authors will also have no access to the submission page.
- **Web site** can be used on the conference Web pages, for example, for making the program. It should be a Web site of the author, not the Web site of her or his organization.
- Each author marked as a **corresponding author** will receive email messages from the system about this submission. There must be at least one corresponding author.
